LIVI (PTY) Ltd – registration number 2024/324495/07 (hereafter called LIVI) is subjected to the Protection of Personal Information Act, no 4 of 2013 ("POPIA") which became operational on 01 July 2020 and section 58-2, effective on 01 July 2021.

STATEMENT

Respecting and protecting your Personal Information**** (refer to the personal information definition at the end of the statement) is important to LIVI. It is also a Constitutional right, legal, and good business practice requirement, which we take very seriously.

In line with the 8 Conditions in the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 of 2013 (the Act), LIVI

- accepts joint responsibility and accountability with you to responsibly manage and protect your Personal Information when providing our services and solutions to you.
- Undertakes to receive, only from you, and process the Personal Information that is necessary
 for the purposes of assisting you with your required solutions, conclude the necessarily
 related agreements and consider the legitimate legal interests of everyone concerned, as
 required by the Act and to respect your right to withdraw your consent for the processing of
 your Personal Information.
- Undertake to only use your Personal Information for the purpose required to assist you or provide solutions to you.
- Undertake not to share or further process your Personal Information with anyone if not required for assisting you with your solutions or by the law.
- Undertake to be open and transparent and notify you as and when required by law regarding why and how your Personal Information needs to be collected.
- Undertake to safeguard and protect your Personal Information in our possession.
- Undertake to freely confirm what Personal Information we have, to update and correct the Personal Information, and to keep it for no longer than legally required.

We and the companies who provide or assist with the solutions you require, need to collect, use, and keep your Personal Information as prescribed by relevant laws and regulations and for reasons such as:

Information Collection: We collect personal information from you when you:

- Register for our services
- Participate in consultations or workshops









- Submit inquiries or feedback
- Use our website or contact us via email

The information we collect may include:

- Name
- Address
- Email address
- Phone number
- Educational background
- Payment information (if applicable)

Use of Information: We use the information collected to:

- Provide educational consulting services
- Communicate with you regarding our services
- Improve our services based on your feedback
- Process payments (if applicable)
- Comply with legal obligations

<u>Children's Privacy</u>: We understand the importance of protecting children's privacy, especially in an educational context. We collect personal information about children only with the consent of a parent or guardian. The information we may collect about children includes:

- Name
- Age
- Educational background
- Learning preferences and needs

We use this information to:

- Tailor educational consulting services to meet the child's needs
- Communicate with parents or guardians regarding the child's progress
- Ensure a safe and supportive learning environment

We do not share children's personal information with third parties, except as required by law or with explicit consent from the parent or guardian.









Data Security: We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, disclosure, or destruction. This includes using secure servers, encryption, and access controls.

****Your Personal Information is defined by the Protection of Personal Information Act (the Act) as: "information relating to an identifiable, living, natural person, and where it is applicable, an identifiable, existing juristic person, including, but not limited to— (a) information relating to the race, gender, sex, pregnancy, marital status, national, ethnic or social origin, colour, sexual orientation, age, physical or mental health, well-being, disability, religion, conscience, belief, culture, language and birth of the person; (b) information relating to the education or the medical, financial, criminal or employment history of the person; (c) any identifying number, symbol, e-mail address, physical address, telephone number, location information, online identifier or other particular assignment to the person; (d) the biometric information of the person; (e) the personal opinions, views or preferences of the person; (f) correspondence sent by the person that is implicitly or explicitly of a private or confidential nature or further correspondence that would reveal the contents of the original correspondence; (g) the views or opinions of another individual about the person; and (h) the name of the person if it appears with other personal information relating to the person or if the disclosure of the name itself would reveal information about the person".
